I earned the rank of Master Sergeant and serving as an Operation Detachment-Alpha Team Sergeant specializing in Military Freefall Operation. Then I was assigned to the United States Special Operation Command as Non-Commission Officer in Charge for the Warriors Care Program at San Antonio Military Medical Center. While in this position, I directly influenced the recovery and rehabilitation of wounded warriors, and assisted family members during the process.

After retiring, I have dedicated my time to supporting the healing and recovery of warriors with the mission of bringing them home, as the Operation Director at Warriors Heart Treatment Center here in Bandera.

Supporting active duty military, veterans, police officers and first responders. I have worked with Texas State Certification boards, Emergency Management Agency and Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for maintaining certification and state requirements.

I care about Bandera and preserving its history while still bring the County into the 21st Century. My wife and I produce “Riding on Faith Rodeo” in Bandera to provide a family orientated environment for locals and visitors to enjoy the cowboy way of life. Also, I am actively involved with my church family at Ridin’ the River Cowboy Fellowship and active with the Bandera Pro Rodeo Board as vice president.
