FLAG DAY is June 14 and the anniversary of the adoption of the Stars and Stripes as the official US flag in 1777, by resolution of the Second Continental Congress.

In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation that established June 14 as Flag Day. It is not an official federal holiday.

LAKE AND RIVER

On June 8, Medina Lake is at 67.7 per cent capacity. The lake level is 1049.12 feet, which is down 15.08 feet.

The Medina River has a flow of 26.4 cfs in Bandera, running 3.74 feet deep at the gage.
