LAKE AND RIVER

On June 30, Medina Lake is at 63.5 per cent capacity. The lake level is 1046.81 feet, which is down 17.39 feet.

The Medina River has a flow of 6.15 cfs in Bandera, running 3.31 feet deep at the gage.
