ELECTION DAY is Tuesday, July 14, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. for the Democratic Party run-off.

Each voter must vote in his or her own precinct.

Locations will be done a little differently this time. The precincts will be consolidated.

Precincts 101 and 102 will vote at the Pipe Creek VFD, 1331 FM 1283, Pipe Creek.

Precincts 203 and 204 will vote at the Lakehills Area Library, 7200 FM 1283, Lakehills.

Precincts 305 and 306 will vote at Ray Mauer Annex, 403 12th St. in Bandera.

Precincts 407, 408, 409 and 410 will vote at Bandera ISD Bus Barn, 1576 Hwy. 173 S, Bandera.

On June 12, Medina Lake is at 62.5 per cent capacity. The lake level is 1046.31 feet, which is down 17.89 feet.

The Medina River has a flow of 7.21 cfs in Bandera, running 3.34 feet deep at the gage.
