The Étouffée will serve two people for \$12; the Jambalaya will also serve two for \$9; a quart of Gumbo sells for \$10; Meat Pies are six for \$15; Crawfish Pies are four for \$18; and Bread Pudding costs \$20 for large, \$10 for medium, and \$6 for small servings.

The food offered is the main fundraising effort this year for the Lakehills Civic Center. Located at 11,225 PR 37 in Lakehills, it is the hub of

activities for the community and focuses on senior citizens and the kiddos.
