On April 9, Medina Lake is at 35.8 per cent capacity. The lake level is 1027.49 feet, which is down 36.71 feet.

The lake valves have been open since March 23. Without rain, our lake is being sucked dry at an alarming rate. Go to Save Medina Lake on Facebook, or the website [SaveMedinaLake.com](http://SaveMedinaLake.com) to be kept informed. The Medina River has a flow of 9.42 cfs in Bandera, standing 3.32 feet deep at the gage.
