### **Baseball**

Bandera's home and home series last week with Wimberley was rough, losing to the Texans there Tuesday and then falling on Friday in Bandera.

Tuesday saw the Texans jump out to an early 9-0 lead after two innings. They added seven more in the third and nine in the fourth to bring the game to an early close after the top of the fifth with a 25-0 lead.

Wimberley was credited with 17 hits for the game and Randon Wheeler had both hits for Bandera.

Friday saw the Texans go up 5-0 in the first on their way to a 12-1 win. Bandera's only run came in the bottom of the second and the Texans scored three in the top of the seventh to pad their lead.

The Bulldogs had seven hits and four errors on the night.

Rodriguez helped the cause with four hits on the night.
