MEMORIAL DAY is a federal holiday for honoring the military personnel who died while serving in the United States Armed Forces. It is observed on the last Monday of May, this year on May 30.

Many people visit cemeteries and memorials on Memorial Day to honor those who died while serving in the military. Volunteers place an American flag on the graves of military personnel.

Memorial Day is also considered the unofficial start of summer in the United States.

Two other days celebrate those who have served or are serving in the US military: Veterans Day, which honors those who have served in the United States Armed Forces; and Armed Forces Day, an unofficial US holiday (earlier in May) for honoring those currently serving in the armed forces.

In 1920, the National American Legion adopted the Poppy as their official symbol of remembrance.

PRIMARY RUN-OFF ELECTION DAY is Tuesday, May 24, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Each voter must vote in their own precinct. Again, precinct voting locations have been combined: Precincts 101 and 102, vote at Pipe Creek VFD, 1331 FM 1283; Precincts 203 and 204, vote at Lakehills Area Library, 7200 FM 1283; Precincts 305 and 306, vote at Ray Mauer Annex, 403 12th St., Bandera; and Precincts 407, 408, 409,

and 410, vote at Bandera ISD Transportation Bus Barn, 1576 Hwy. 173 S., Bandera.
