Get ready for Giving Tuesday

Triple H Equitherapy Center is celebrating Giving Tuesday on Nov. 29 with its second annual Hay Drive and an expression of gratitude. Your support means everything to us. Giving to our Hay Drive ensures that our budget doesn't bust over new hay prices and our herd of 25 therapy horses get the best quality care.

Right now, a bale of hay costs \$13. On average, each horse eats five flakes from a bale costing \$1 each or \$5 for five flakes—every single day of the year. That averages \$125 of hay per day for the herd (\$3,750 a month).

Between the drought and inflation, it's been a challenge. Our herd will need lots of hay during the upcoming winter months because there's almost no grass for grazing in the pastures. In turn, these four-legged therapists will improve the health and change the lives of some of the most vulnerable individuals in our community—veterans with PTSD, children with special needs, and young people who experienced adverse childhood experiences resulting in serious behavioral issues.

You can help a therapy horse improve the life of a person struggling with physical or mental challenges by donating to our hay drive.
