SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Economic Development Corporation

The EDC is charged with the responsibility of promoting economic development and advising City Council with regard to incentives as they relate to the City's development within the commercial and industrial districts. All policy efforts of the EDC are designed to help strengthen and diversify the local economy. The EDC meets on the third Tuesday of each month at 6:00 pm at Bandera City Hall, 511 Main Street, Bandera, Texas.
